### **CCDBA COVID-19 POLICY**

EFFECTIVE: April 10, 2022

This policy applies to any CCDBA or team-sponsored activity. The Board of Directors can change the policy at any time. Everyone engages in dragon boating on a voluntary basis. Your safety is your responsibility. READ EACH SECTION.



#### 1. VACCINATIONS/FACE COVERINGS:

CCDBA strongly encourages every paddler to get Covid-19 vaccinations as recommended by the Center for Disease Control (CDC). Dragon boat festivals, clinics and other events might require proof of vaccination. Paddlers are always welcome to wear face coverings for extra protection.

#### COMPLY WITH ANNOUNCED REQUIREMENTS:

CCDBA follows Covid-19 guidelines issued by the CDC, state and local health agencies; CCDBA will notify paddlers of any changes in the guidelines, via announcement on TeamSnap and on the website <a href="mailto:ccdba.org">ccdba.org</a>. ALL PADDLERS must watch for Covid announcements and comply with any announced requirements.

## 3. STAY AWAY:

If a paddler has symptoms of Covid-19, or is feeling ill in any way, the paddler must stay away from practices, team events and all other CCDBA paddlers until the symptoms have ended AND the paddler has a negative test for Covid-19. Paddlers who test positive for Covid-19 must stay away until the paddler has tested negative AND has completed doctor or CDC-recommended quarantine or isolation.

# 4. NOTIFY OF POSITIVE TEST:

Any paddler who tests positive for Covid-19 within 5 days of attending a dragon boat practice or team event must IMMEDIATELY notify CCDBA by e-mailing <a href="mailto:president@ccdba.org">president@ccdba.org</a>, or texting any board member. The board will notify other paddlers of a possible exposure via e-mail on TeamSnap.
